Located above the springs, the church at Chick Springs served the community for some twenty years before moving to the present location on Main St., Taylors, and changing it's name to Taylors Baptist Church.

This member roll was the first in the church records and was added to up into the early 1870s. A few names repeat and some dates aren't specific whether a death or membership.

The names represent families living in the community during the time. Most are descendants of the earliest settlers in the area.
